Dress Code

On the course

Whilst playing the course or using the Practice Field all Members and Guests are required to wear APPROPRIATE GOLF ATTIRE including golf shoes

The following are **NOT** considered to be appropriate

Track suit tops and bottoms
"T" Shirts
Football Style Shirts
Sleeveless Shirts *
Denim Jeans
Beach/Leisure/Combat Shorts
Combat Trousers
Heavily logoed or numbered tops
Shirts worn outside trousers or shorts

In the Clubhouse

Smart casual wear is permitted in the Clubhouse at all times and provided clothing is not wet or soiled a change from golf attire is not necessary.

Golf shoes are not allowed in the Lounge or Dining Room

Gentlemen will be expected to wear trousers in the Dining Room.

All Members and Guests will be expected to maintain an ACCEPTABLE STANDARD of appearance whilst on Club premises

The following are **NOT** considered acceptable

Wet or soiled clothing/shoes
Caps or hats
Sleeveless Shirts *
Denim apparel
Beach/Leisure/Combat Shorts
Combat Trousers
Heavily logoed or numbered tops
Track suit tops and bottoms
"T" Shirts
Football Style Shirts
Shirts worn outside trousers/shorts (unless tailored shirt)*
Training Shoes/Pumps (unless under 18 years of age)

(* Ladies may wear these items)

All Members, the Professional, the Directors, the General Manager & the Bar & Catering Manager have the right to refuse and should refuse anyone access to the course or clubhouse if they are considered not to be conforming to the dress code.

Members and guests who persistently abuse the dress code rules are liable to disciplinary action

If the occasion demands the Directors can use their discretion to relax the above dress code rules for a club organised function or outside party.
